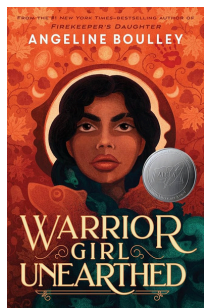


# Warrior Girl Unearthed

## Blood Debts

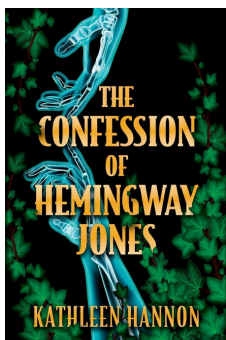

by Kathleen Hannon

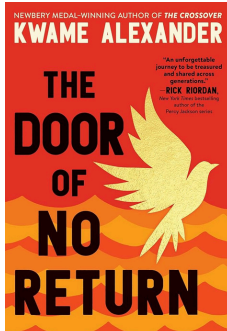

by Kwame Alexander

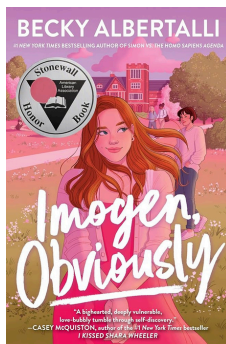

by Becky Albertalli

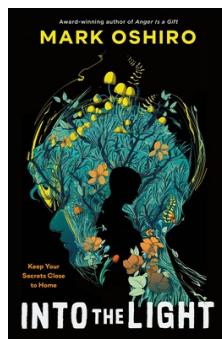
