- 1. We approved the minutes from the January 21, 2025 meeting without changes.
- 2. Treasurer's Report: Closing balance \$4,570.16 in the checking account, \$20,000 in Certificate of Deposit that matures on 3/31/2025 and 5/1/2025. We approved the Report which is attached.
- 3. Charitable Gaming update: we are assigned Oct 3-12 at the Hampton Beach casino which are considered excellent dates. The paperwork has been completed.
- 4. Fund Raising update:

- 5. Literary Fair, April 4-5: there will be a concert with Sharon Jones on the first night of the Fair. Susan will pursue the idea of a "Taste of Exeter" for the opening evening of the Lit Fest. She will reach out to restaurants to donate finger or other food for the event. In addition the group strongly endorsed a food drive to benefit area residents.
- 6. Crafts Fair: May 3. Friends will set up the raffle with craft items donated by the vendors. Andrea Perry agreed to take the lead on the Crafts Fair raffle in May, following the procedures documented by Sarah James.
- 7. Cribbage: there was a good turn out on February 8.
- 8. Library Needs: musicians are needed for each of the summer months: June, July and August. Poco Amare is already set for June. The Children's Library's juggler is getting expensive but is immensely popular. The Friends will fund these.
- 9. Hope Godino is retiring at the end of the month and there will be a retirement party on Friday February 21st from 2-6. The Exeter community is invited and the Friends will bring finger foods.
- 10. Julia Lanter is the new Director of the Exeter Public Library.
